


Katharina Freifrau von Perfall

Board member of PIN.

Katharina von Perfall has been a board member of the PIN since 1998. After six years as chair of the board of the association, she took over the post of deputy in 2016. After studying art history at the Courtauld Institute in London and the University of Heidelberg, Katharina von Perfall worked as an art critic for the Frankfurter Allgemeine and Die Wochenpost. From 1990 to 2009, she was active as art consultant, whereas she has increasingly focused on private collections of contemporary art since 2004. She applies her expertise to building corporate collections and initiating and realizing architecture-related works of art by artists such as Gerhard Richter, Dan Flavin, Juan Munoz, Daniel Buren and Robert Barry. Katharina von Perfall is author of numerous catalog contributions.

Freelance author and art critic

Oliver Koerner von Gustorf lives and works as freelance author and art critic in Berlin and Ringenwalde, Uckermark. After she had completed her studies, the art historian and art advisor founded MM-Artmanagement (mm-artmanagement.de), a service company for private and corporate art collections. Today she advises corporations such as Hubert Burda Media or Roland Berger as well as many private collectors. The promotion of young artists is particularly important to her. In 2021 she founded the art community Wunderkunst.shop. Mon Muellerschoen gives lectures on art, curates exhibitions and lives for her passion, art. She is known to a broad public through her weekly art column in BUNTE magazine.

Director of "Museen der Stadt Dresden", art historian, author, curator and museum manager

After Gisbert Porstmann had completed his studies, the art historian, author, curator and museum manager worked as a freelance art historian in Berlin. He did research on, among others, medieval art and culture, art and literature of Enlightenment, John Heartfield and on contemporary art. He then became a research assistant at the Museum of Fine Arts in Leipzig. In 2002 he was appointed founding director of the municipal art museum in Dresden. He developed the fundamental museum and exhibition concept for the Städtische Galerie Dresden and curated numerous exhibitions. In 2009 he took over management of the municipal museum association "Museums of the City of Dresden" and continues to work as director of the Städtische Galerie Dresden.

ARTIST STATEMENT

In my artistic work, the focus is on landscape painting. Nature in all its complexity is an important source of inspiration for me. However, my goal is not to replicate it in a naturalistic way; instead, I am interested in the potential function of a picture to expand spaces beyond what is visible.

In my current work, I am dealing with gardens. Gardens are an environment that has been controlled and reshaped by humans. They are a piece of land, a microcosm of their own, where nature has lost its wilderness to order. My abstract garden paintings also stand alone at first; in the context of the painting's spatial surface, forms, spaces, colors, and light come together. The formal repetitions, which I execute with great care and control, give the surface of the canvas an order that, while it may contradict the wilderness of nature, also attempts to harmoniously complement it.



ARTIST STATEMENT

In my artistic practice, I explore the philosophical aspects of human relationships, space and identity, and attempt to understand the complex dynamics that shape them. My works explore interdisciplinary interactions of shifting polarities such as nomadism and sedentarism – deconstruction and reconstruction – past and future.

Drawing and painting are the main media I use, however, I often combine them with objects, photography, text and installation. In my artistic process I frequently integrate found objects such as old Ikea shelves, chests of drawers, tables and other objects from the former GDR, as well as yellowed maps. These objects carry personal and geographical significance and encourage the development of a spatial perception. The use of materials that show traces of use and the passing of time evokes nostalgia, which moves in time and place and connects the individual with the collective, leading to their new understanding.

By experimenting with materials and different approaches that cannot easily be categorized as gestural or conceptual, my works create new frameworks for the concepts of everyday objects, interior and exterior space, contemporary culture and spatial theory.



ARTIST STATEMENT

My artistic journey began with everyday objects that at first convey a sense of familiarity. But the attentive viewer quickly realizes that these motifs are deliberately composed. They are artfully manipulated to construct specific scenes. This methodical arrangement gives the images a certain intention and reminds the viewer of the artist's role in creating the paintings, prompting them to think: Why? What is their meaning?

Mystery and vagueness are elements that I want to preserve in my art. Painting serves as a medium for interaction between the viewer and myself, and should invite the viewer to ask questions and thus also to return them. The titles of my works therefore often do not directly refer to the motif, but rather summarize memories, impressions and the artist's feelings.

This indirect expression could be due to my innate shyness. The paintings are waiting to be questioned, rather than expressing themselves. Nevertheless, I strive to ensure that my work does not become overly personal. Keeping a diary for my own benefit was never the goal of my painting. It is a language for communication, but not a very loud one.

ARTIST STATEMENT

For my paintings, I use graphic templates from my own extensive archive of analog and digital drawings, found objects and AI images. I then collage these fragments or drawings onto the paintings. In doing so, it is important to me to dispense with a clear line of reading and logic. I see these symbols and their content as formal elements with an open and variable meaning. This allows the motifs to unfurl freely and achieve an anti-symbolic effect.

My aim is to dismantle established interpretations and blur their meaning in order to create a world of images multilayered in terms of motifs and imprecise in terms of semantics. The graphic elements found in each of the paintings dissolve into a new, illegible narrative. But they also enter into a dialogue with each other and merge with the painting in a hybrid way. My primary concern lies in the ambivalence between form and design and the paradox of the content itself.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Has the center of our perception changed, our self-understanding of the world, of being, since we started to generate our own light? The greatest invention after fire was the discovery of electricity. Moths cannot escape artificial light, they are caught by it. Their innate mechanism of movement forces them to revolve around this source, they cannot escape it, except by a random external force that pushes them away, a gust of wind or the like.

It imitates the sun and the moth cannot distinguish between the two. But they could hardly be more different. The one gives the moth life and orientation, it guides it to life, to the destination, the sun.

The other captures it, confuses it, imprisons it, makes it aimless, dependent, and slowly brings it to death through exhaustion, the artificial light. Have we gone too far, or not yet?

With this emancipation from daylight, from the sun, from nature and its cycles, humanity has also created completely new points of reference. We no longer have to be guided by natural cycles, at least that is what we think in the wake of the technological triumphs of our time, and we create new, self-made centers of the world.




How can I adapt to the habitat I have chosen? My art reflects these questions regarding my personal history. By depicting natural elements, I try to visualize human emotions or sections of a nomadic life. My art addresses my longing for the right to appropriate spaces and my longing for a settled life.



Now that I live far away from my family in Germany, the longing for my childhood and memories of my family are reflected in my artistic work.


For me, painting the dog bus series is both a journey to understand the meaning of family and part of my personal healing process.



Erosion, time, and geological movements inspire my creative process. Through ceramics, scents, videos, and performances, I explore the connection between all the planet's phenomena and how our existence relates to them. My work begins with contemplative actions in which I move matter from one place to another, like stones from the mountains to the sea or water from the ocean to the inland, drawing paths that show the geological and physical relationships of all elements. These traces merge with burnt clay, moving images, or installation scents. ARTIST STATEMENT

My paintings convey the encounter of man with his history. Human history reflects the process of self-discovery. I see cultural identity and its trajectories as the core of recurrent social and political phenomena. My works juxtapose representations of man from different eras, such as rock paintings and artifacts excavated from the earth, which in turn serve as archaeological information carriers.

The materials I use indicate change and transience. Paper is not only an image carrier, but also a material that offers great flexibility, for example when using the paper pulp as paint. I make my own gall ink, the color of which darkens over time and cannot be erased without leaving traces. The traditional crafts of paper making and ink production are translated into a contemporary form.



ARTIST STATEMENT

In my artistic endeavors, I combine various techniques and forms of representation to approach themes such as the subjectivity of perception, interpersonal relationships and intimacy. Drawing is at the center of this process, as I find it to be the most direct medium of expression for a personal confrontation. I often need nothing more than a pencil and a sheet of paper to do my work.

Since my final year, I have also been working in drawing with digital photos that I took with my mobile phone. With the help of acetone, I transfer digital prints onto an analog image carrier by hand, resulting in hybrid traces that sometimes represent recognizable elements and sometimes remain non-representational.

In the works „In der Hauptstraße 159“ and „Im Kleistpark“, I have intensively explored the representation of places that I know from my childhood and youth, but which have hardly changed in physical appearance. For me, both places are places of rest in the rotation of time.

Over the years, he has explored and deconstructed the visual language of euro banknotes and other objects of value. With his deceptively simple artworks, he manages to explore the complexity of representations of value and power, while questioning ideas about the inner structures of economics. ARTIST STATEMENT

Being an artist, I am inspired by my childhood, by memories of both the happy and sad times. That is why I take a very playful approach to my work, allowing compositions characterized by chance to emerge in the process. Sometimes I enjoy remembering the world from a child's perspective, a world that was simpler and much more impressive. As an artist, I try to take on the role of a child and regard my work as a toy. My childhood is strongly associated with my grandmother and my native country Vietnam. Sewing and dressmaking are still an important part of our culture. My grandmother not only raised me, but also taught me a passion for sewing, different fabrics and techniques. No wonder sewing has become an important part of my work. I am interested in the versatility of fabrics, which I can change by using color and tension. Each fabric offers a different range of emotions such as joy, sadness or excitement. From the structure of the fabric, its thickness, texture, density, absorbency, it gains unforeseen properties in combination with color and tautness. My work starts with the individual processing of a fabric, choosing the texture, cutting it to size, then dyeing and painting it, and finally sewing and tautening it. During these process steps, I consider which fabrics and colors harmonize with each other. A certain image that I create instinctively emerges. The texture of the fabrics and the different levels of a work create space within the space. A symbiosis between the environment and the work emerges. Does our perception change through a perforation on a two-dimensional surface? Does it then become an object or does it remain a picture? Transparent fabrics such as silk also turn a surface into a space. The picture frame is no longer hidden; light and shadow become important components of my works. The "materiality" of my works in connection with the spatiality are important elements. With my artistic work, I preserve the past in the present.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Maxine Weiss's artistic production encompasses sculpture, installation, research projects and video. She takes a material-based approach in which all components stand in a reciprocal and non-hierarchical relationship to one another. She engages in an experimental exploration of materials, with much of her work being process-oriented and emerging from chance encounters. She combines industrially produced materials with found objects and organic components. Botanical elements play a central role in her work, reflecting cultural, historical and economic aspects. Accompanied by ephemeral aesthetics, these botanical elements can appear familiar and yet strangely alien. Maxine seeks to foster alternative mindsets that recognize a world in which non-human entities have as much influence as human actions on their environment. With this co-existential approach, she seeks to dissolve the dualistic distinction between nature and culture through physical and virtual connections. An integral part of Maxine's artistic practice is research, reading and discussion, all of which inform the material compositions.

Maxine Weiss completed her studies as a master student at the Academy of Fine Arts in Munich under Prof. Alexandra Bircken and Prof. Raphaela Vogel in 2024. She spent a year at the Beaux-Arts de Marseille in 2021/2022. Prior to that, she studied art history and cultural anthropology in Munich, Freiburg, Paris and Vienna.



ARTIST STATEMENT

The exploration of buildings, consumer products and media in the context of social dynamics is at the heart of my artistic endeavors. I am particularly interested in the relationship between aesthetic and social norms, as exemplified by our living spaces and the promises that the different facets of capitalism hold. My works, which are mostly sculptures, reference existing designs and combine them to create new, hybrid objects. They often suggest a certain functionality by imitating industrial surface aesthetics. Installations combine these elements to create arrangement modeled on commercial, domestic or sacred contexts. In recent works I have addressed the specifically (West) German idea of an egalitarian middle-class society, most recently in the context of the topic of home ownership. In addition to campaigns by politicians, companies and banks, I draw on a visual canon of my hometown of Bad Krozingen in southern Baden.







Definitions under the European GDPR made transparent for you:

Personal Data

Personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (hereinafter „data subject“). An identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier, or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social identity of that natural person.

Processing of Your Personal Data

“Processing” means any operation or set of operations performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure, or destruction.

Consent

“Consent” of the data subject means any freely given, specific, in formed, and unambiguous indication of the data subject’s wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her.

We also need this from you – whereby this is granted by you completely voluntarily – in the event that either we ask you for personal data that is not required for the performance of a contract or to take action prior to contract formation, and/or where the lawfulness criteria set out in Art. 6 (1) sentence 1, letters c) - f) of the GDPR would otherwise not be met.

In the event consent is required, we will request this from you **separately**. If you do not grant the consent, we absolutely will not process such data.

Personal data that you provide to us for purposes of performance of a contract or to take action prior to contract formation and which is required for such purposes and processed by us accordingly includes, for example:

- Your contact details, such as name, address, phone, fax, e-mail, tax ID, etc., as well as financial information such as credit card or bank account details if required for transactions of a financial nature;
- Shipping and invoice details, information on what type of taxation you are requesting (regular taxation or differential taxation) and other information you provide for the purchase, offer, or other services provided by us or for the shipping of an item;

At the same time, we have the right in connection with contract fulfillment and for purposes of taking appropriate actions that lead to contract formation to obtain supplemental information from third parties (for example: if you assume obligations to us, we generally have the right to have your creditworthiness verified by a credit reporting agency within the limits allowed by law. Such necessity exists in particular due to the special characteristics of auction sales, since in the event your bid is declared the winning

bid, you will be depriving the next highest bidder of the possibility of purchasing the artwork. Therefore your credit standing – regarding which we always maintain the strictest confidentiality – is extremely important.)

Registration/Logging in/Providing personal data when contacting us

You can choose to register with us and provide your personal data either directly (over the phone, through the mail, via e-mail, or by fax) or on our website. You would do this, for example, if you would like to participate in an online auction and/or are interested in certain works of art, artists, styles, eras, etc., or want to offer us (for example) pieces of art for purchase or sale.

Which personal data you will be providing to us is determined based on the respective input screen that we use for the registration or for your inquiries, or the information that we will be requesting from you or that you will be providing voluntarily. The personal data that you enter or provide for this purpose is collected and stored solely for internal use by us and for our own purposes.

We have the right to arrange for this information to be disclosed to one or more external data processors, which will likewise use it solely for internal use imputed to the processor’s data controller.

When you show an interest in certain works of art, artists, styles, eras, etc., be this through your above-mentioned participation at registration, through your interest in selling, consignment for auction, or purchase, in each case accompanied by the voluntary provision of your personal data, this simultaneously allows us to notify you of services offered by our auction house and our company that are closely associated in the art marketplace with our auction house, to provide you with targeted marketing materials, and to send you promotional offers on the basis of your profile by phone, fax, mail, or e-mail. If there is a specific form of notification that you prefer, we will be happy to arrange to meet your needs once informed of these. On the basis of your aforementioned interests, including your participation in auctions, we will be continually reviewing in accordance with Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR whether we are permitted to advertise to you and, if so, what kind of advertising may be used for this purpose (for example: sending auction catalogs, providing information on special events, future or past auctions, etc.).

You have the right to object to this contact with you at any time as stated in Art. 21 of the GDPR (see below: “Your Rights Relating to the Processing of Your Personal Data”).

Live Auctions

In so-called live auctions, one or more cameras or other audio and video recording devices are directed toward the auctioneer and the respective works of art being offered at auction. Generally, such data can be received simultaneously via the Internet by anyone using this medium. Ketterer Kunst takes the strongest precautions to ensure that no one in the room who has not been specifically designated by Ketterer Kunst to be on camera with their consent for the auction process is captured on camera. Nevertheless, Ketterer Kunst cannot assume any responsibility for whether individuals in the auction hall themselves actively enter the respective frame, for example by deliberately or unknowingly stepping partially or completely in front of the respective camera, or by

moving through the scene. In such situation, through their participation in or attendance at the public auction, the respective individuals involved are agreeing to the processing of their personal data in the form of their personal image for the purposes of the live auction (transmission of the auction via audio and video).

Your Rights Relating to the Processing of Your Personal Data

Pursuant to the provisions of the GDPR, you have the following rights in particular:

- The right to information on stored personal data concerning yourself, free of charge, the right to receive a copy of this information, and the other rights in this connection as stated in Art. 15 of the GDPR.

Furthermore, Directive 2002/58/EC notwithstanding, you are always free in connection with the use of information society services to exercise your right to object by means of automated processes for which technical specifications are applied.

Right to Complain Under Art. 77 of the GDPR

How Long We Store Data

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that in the case of contracts, the archiving period does not start until the end of the contract term. We would also like to advise you that in the case of cultural property, we are obligated pursuant to Sec. 45 in conjunction with Sec. 42 of the German Cultural Property Protection Act (Kulturgutschutzgesetz) to record proof of meeting our due diligence requirements and will retain certain personal data for this purpose for a period of 30 years. Once the periods prescribed by law or necessary to pursue or defend against claims (e.g., statutes of limitations) have expired, the corresponding data is routinely deleted. Data not subject to storage periods and obligations is deleted once the storage of such data is no longer required for the performance of activities and satisfaction of duties under the contract. If you do not have a contractual relationship with us but have shared your personal data with us, for example because you would like to obtain information about our services or you are interested in the purchase or sale of a work of art, we take the liberty of assuming that you would like to remain in contact with us, and that we may thus process the personal data provided to us in this context until such time as you object to this on the basis of your aforementioned rights under the GDPR, withdraw your consent, or exercise your right to ensure data transmission.
